**HAWAII WATER SERVICE COMPANY – KA’ANAPALI DIVISION  
ENERGY USE AND EFFICIENCY REPORT**

(For the quarter ended December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2016)

In Ordering Paragraph No. 5 of Decision and Order No. 33908 filed in Docket No. 2015-0230 on September 12, 2016, the Hawaii Public Utilities Commission (the “Commission”) ordered Hawaii Water Service Company (“HWSC”) to file quarterly energy use and efficiency reports with the Commission. The Commission further ordered that said reports shall, at a minimum, include descriptions of: (A) HWSC’s renewable energy self-generation efforts; and (B) HWSC’s efforts in utilizing demand response to reduce its energy costs.

Because this the first energy use and efficiency report for the Ka’anapali Division, the following report describes efforts HWSC has made in recent years to reduce electricity costs and convert from non-renewable to renewable sources.

1. HWSC participates in the Rider M program. Currently, 3 of HWSC’s wells are on the Rider M Program: P2, P5, and Honokowai. HWSC has plans to start a pilot program in 2018 with MECO to determine if any other wells are eligible for the Rider M program.
